



NOW, YOUR OUTFIT!
Dependent on what company it is then this will depend on your outfit! Corporate (finance / legal / government) I would go suited and booted (give your shoes a good polish too!)
BUT
The majority of companies Hargreaves Recruitment deal with have a smart / casual / wear what you want policy.
(If in doubt, please contact the person that arranged your interview and ask them for the dress code but smart casual will always be a winner!)
Most employers will go through what is called a competency interview (https://www.glassdoor.co.uk/blog/competency-based-interview/) so make sure you run through a couple of examples before you arrive and make sure they are work related.
Make sure you know your CV back to front as you may be asked questions on this.
Also – use the notes you have done the research on to ask questions at the end (if you feel comfortable)
Finally, the last crucial bit of advice I can give you, JUST BE YOU!!!! Don't ever put on a front because you think this will please the interviewer. Most companies will recruit based on 50% can you do the job and 50% do you fit into their company

Just remember - deep breaths, keep your cool and you've got this!
